

Arrival and Check In Procedure

Gate: This event will have an active “gate” to check you in. However, the gate will only be active at certain times of the day. Make sure you plan to arrive between those times!

Gate Opens: Tuesday, March 14, 2023, at 0800 (8am)

Gate Closes: Wednesday, March 15, 2023, at 2200 (10pm)

Tuesday: The gate officially opens to check people in on Tuesday (March 14). If you arrive at check-in, there will be someone manning the gate.

Wednesday: The gate will be open, as like Tuesday. (Event goes live today. Please plan to arrive on either Wednesday or sooner)

Thursday: The gate will be CLOSED. If you arrive on Thursday, do not expect event staff to make your check-in a priority. You will be admitted, but you might have to wait a few hours.

Friday/Saturday: The gate is CLOSED all day! DO NOT PLAN TO ARRIVE FRIDAY OR SATURDAY!

Arriving after 10pm: There will likely be no one to check you in after 10pm. There will be plenty of other participants’ cars in the area. Find a suitable place to park, you will have to wait until morning to be checked in. My personal advice, plan to arrive at the gate by 8pm at the latest, that way if there are any delays, you can still make it in before 10pm.

Arrival: Immediately park near the Cantina, all participants walk to the check-in table and perform the check-in procedure.

Check-in Procedure

1. Initial Check-in: Approach the check-in table, verify your attendance, and sign the waiver.
2. Unload your vehicle with all of the gear and uniforms you need for the event. Kit-out and get your gear together. Put modern clothes in the vehicle. Expect to not return to your vehicle until the event is over.
3. Re-park your vehicle in designated parking, at the General Store (about a quarter of a mile north of the cantina) and walk back to the cantina. **We recommend you leave your wallet in the car, to prevent loss in the field!**
4. Complete Check-in: Surrender car keys and cell phones. Dont worry, they will be kept safe, and vehicles will be under 24 hour supervision of the property owner. Exceptions are made on a case by case basis. Dont forget to call or text anyone you need and let them know you made it to the site and are safe. The purpose is to remove the risk of losing those essential items in the field, and to help boost immersion. If you lose your cell phone or keys in this event, you will never find them. There is no reception and you should not be visiting your vehicle during the event anyway. Dont worry, they will be well organized and kept safe!
5. After check-in is complete, stand by. A period vehicle will ferry you to your respective HQ/Camp in due time.

Arrival to HQ

Immediately find your Commanding Officer (either Chris Grant, or Frank Beuter), or report to the next rank in the chain of command. Announce your arrival to them, they will put you on the roster, and you will be given instruction.
